

CITY OF SHAKOPEE ROAD PROJECTS 2019

Road construction season is here, and that means a variety of new construction and pavement maintenance projects throughout the community. PROJECT: Street & Utility Reconstruction

WHERE: Scott Street from Fourth Avenue to Sixth Avenue; Minnesota Street cul-de-sac south of Fourth Avenue; and Seventh Avenue from Spencer Street to Somerville Street.

NUTS & BOLTS: Replace aging pipes; construct new roadways, including sidewalk and concrete curb and gutter.

ESTIMATED TIMELINE: May-September

TRAFFIC IMPACT: Closed to through traffic throughout project.

PROJECT: Pavement Rehabilitation

WHERE: Southbridge area; Sarazin Street from St. Francis Avenue to Mooers Avenue; and Fairhaven Drive, Abbey Point, Cambridge Way and Langston Court.

NUTS & BOLTS: Repair cracks, bituminous patching and chip sealcoat or new pavement overlay (where appropriate).

ESTIMATED TIMELINE: June-August

TRAFFIC IMPACT: Closed for short durations; temporary no overnight parking.

PROJECT: Crack Sealing

WHERE: Various locations, see areas in blue on map.

NUTS & BOLTS: Blows out cracks and fills with rubber. The material is then covered with biodegradable toilet paper. Can be messy.

ESTIMATED TIMELINE: May

TRAFFIC IMPACT: Watch for no parking signs, as vehicles must be off the road during the process. Move parked vehicles away from end of the driveway due to blown rock and debris. It is OK to drive over the paper.

PROJECT: Sealcoating

WHERE: Various locations, see areas in orange on map.

NUTS & BOLTS: Uses a mix of heated liquid asphalt and small rock to provide an effective barrier against water intrusion, aging and oxidation. Can be a messy and very dusty operation.

While crews sweep streets of surplus rock days and weeks after installation, some chips will continue to release over time, resulting in excess rock along curbs and in yards.

ESTIMATED TIMELINE: June-July

TRAFFIC IMPACT: Watch for no parking signs, as vehicles must be off the road during the process. No lawn mowing or watering for 24 hours after work is complete.

PROJECT: 12th Avenue Reconstruction

WHERE: 12th Avenue from Vierling Drive to County Highway 83 intersection and Vierling Drive from Eagle Creek Boulevard to 12th Avenue.

NUTS & BOLTS: Reconstruct street and utilities; construct roundabout, trails and sidewalks; and street lighting.

ESTIMATED TIMELINE: May-November

TRAFFIC IMPACT: Intersection of 12th Avenue and Vierling Drive will be closed from late July to November. Access to local businesses will be maintained.

PROJECT: Lateral Sewer Pipe Rehabilitation

WHERE: Various locations, see areas in yellow on map.

NUTS & BOLTS: Install a new pipe inside the existing lateral pipe from the sewer main to a point just beyond the street edge. This technique has been shown to strengthen pipes and reduce the chance of failure.

ESTIMATED TIMELINE: July-October

TRAFFIC IMPACT: Minimal impact to traffic. Homeowners may have restricted sewer access for short periods of time.

PROJECT: Shenandoah Drive Construction

WHERE: Shenandoah Drive between Eastway Avenue and Vierling Drive.

NUTS & BOLTS: Construct utilities and roadway, two roundabouts, street lighting, trails, sidewalks and landscaping.

ESTIMATED TIMELINE: Current-Late summer 2019

TRAFFIC IMPACT: Closed through late summer 2019.

PROJECT: 12th Avenue Trail Construction

WHERE: South side of 12th Avenue from County Highway 83, along Gateway Drive to Quarry Lake Trail.

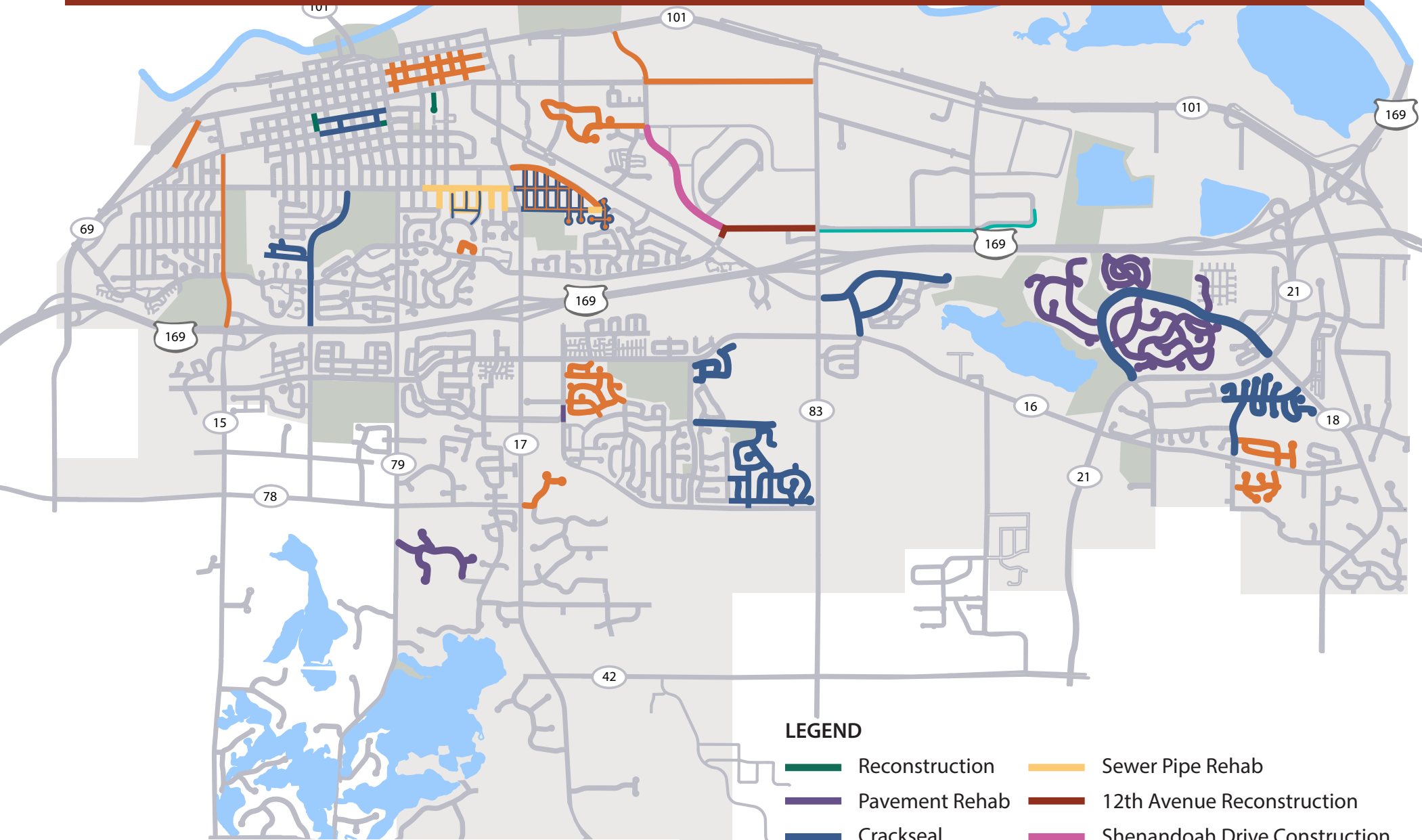
NUTS & BOLTS: Construct a new bituminous trail.

ESTIMATED TIMELINE: July-October






TRAFFIC IMPACT: Minimal impact; possible lane closures on 12th Avenue.
